Our journey takes us along parts of the ancient Silk Road, through ancient legends and harsh realities, through past and present, steppes and mountains - the most famous of which is Mount Damavand, a dormant volcano and highest peak in Iran with a special place in the Persian mythology and folklore. Just like in the past, travellers from Iran's different ethnic groups in Iran - such as the Mazandarani people, Turkmen, Armenian or Afghan - meet and interconnect. All of them have boarded Ali's red bus for a different purpose and have their own story to tell while we travel through ancient lands and stunning landscapes.
