Norie, a young Japanese student, came to Latvia to study the country's Sui culture *) - a small Catholic community in the western part of the country, surrounded by Lutheran provinces.

What began as a purely academic project turned into a rare and profound human bonding between a young girl from the Land of the Rising Sun and an old lady from an almost extinct community.
