Following a report that has not been made public by the Ministry of the Interior in France, the government has voted an "anti-gang" law in 2010. This new law allows - among others - to repress any suspicion of violence as well as any constitution of gangs, even before an offence is committed.

For a whole year, he has now returned to his old neighbourhood with his camera in order to understand the phenomena of gang culture and its consequences.

He met with young people - Tarek, Issam, Richard and others - who would like to see an end to this territory rivalry. I also met with local MPs who wish for a safe neighbourhood for their constituents and with parents who want the best for their children...
