It's an arduous climb, but worth the effort when reaching the top of the mountain where a range of telescopes scan the sky and especially our star, the sun. This ball of gas of 1.4 million kilometers in diameter and 5500°C is in perpetual activity. By observing the impressive eruptions of the sun that project into space electrically charged particles, the researchers hope to be able to prevent them to threaten our planet.
