

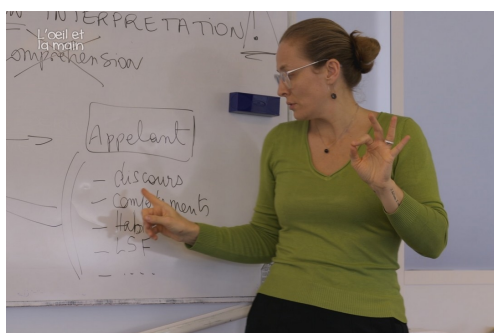


19. SOS-SURDUS - THE ART OF LISTENING
