Working on these texts is also an opportunity for these young deaf people to express themselves on such an intimate and delicate topic.

Will the other listen to it, share it? Will he or she welcome this part of oneself that we offer, or will we be mocked, rejected or humiliated?

The words of the students echo the scenes of school life and gradually bring out their emotions and fragments of their personal stories.
